Check Before Burning @

www.ontario.ca/page/forest-fires

You are responsible for fires you light, meaning responsibility for any costs in response/damages is yours!

The Hazard Ratings and what they mean:

LOW: Burning Permitted – Permit is Required

MODERATE: Burning Permitted – Requires Additional Caution – Permit is Required

HIGH: Dangerous Conditions – Open-Air Burning is Restricted. Exception: Campfires as described in Open-Air Burning By-law – Permit is Required

EXTREME: Total Fire Ban. NO FIRES PERMITTED.

ITEMS ACCEPTED AS FOLLOWS:

Aerosols; Antifreeze; Batteries – Consumer-Type-Portable (single use dry cell); Batteries – Rechargeable; Batteries – Industrial Stationary and Non-Lead Acid Motive; Corrosives (includes irritants); Fertilizers; Fire Extinguishers (portable); Flammables (includes solvents); Fluorescents (User removed); Fluorescents (imbedded in designated EE Leachates); Mercury Devices (includes measuring devices, switches and thermostats); Oil containers; Oil Filters; Paint and Coatings; Pesticides, Fungicides and/or Herbicides; Pharmaceuticals; Pressurized Containers; Reactives; Sharps, Syringes; Toxics.

The current Livestock Valuer’s are Harold Kelly (807) 482-1431 or (807) 271-2510; Robert Gibson (807) 487-2643; and Nico Veldhuisen (807) 482-2593 or (807) 276-6860. If you have a wolf kill claim, please contact them. To be a valid Livestock Damages claim you need a Farm Business Registration #, and a Premise Id. DO NOT MOVE THE REMAINS before the Valuer can view the scene.
