

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CHAPPLE
COUNCIL MEETING
November 27, 2015**

The special meeting of the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Chapple was held on Friday, November 27, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. in the Municipal Office, Barwick Ontario.

PRESENT: Reeve Peter Van Heyst, Councillors: Ken Wilson, Ted Zimmerman, and Rilla Race, and CAO/Clerk Treasurer Peggy Johnson.

Reeve Peter Van Heyst welcomed everyone and declared the meeting open for the transaction of business.

1. Moved by: Ted Zimmerman – Rilla Race

2. Moved by: Rilla Race – Ken Wilson

That By-law 1551, being a by-law for the Corporation of the Township of Chapple authorizing the Reeve and CAO/Clerk Treasurer to resolve to enter into a conditional building permit agreement (NL 15-04) with New Gold, be read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 27th day of November, 2015.

3. Moved by: Ken Wilson – Ted Zimmerman

That Council Meeting Per Diem's for the Corporation of the Township of Chapple be paid on a per meeting basis plus applicable mileage.

Ken Wilson advised Council that Vaughan Wilson had expressed concern at not being paged out to fire events and that he had no pager. It had been reported that there had been issues with the pagers. CAO will follow-up with Fire Chief Joshua Colling as to supply of pagers for the department.

Ken Wilson advised Council that Vaughan Wilson expressed concern over ice not being put in at the North Fire Hall. Council had previously identified the skating rink within the village as a priority and did not want to compromise water supply at the North Fire Hall by flooding the rink with water from the well and holding tanks. If ice were to be put in, water would have to be hauled with the fire truck.

Vaughan had advised that members of the Recreation Committee would volunteer to put in the ice. Discussion will need to be held with Fire Chief/Joshua Colling as to the use of the fire truck and the possibility of doing this as part of the volunteers training.
