

# **SORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR LANDFILLS**

## **Household**

- \* Household garbage
- \* Cement – cement blocks, large chunks of broken cement
- \* Plastic, glass, painted pallets, shingles, insulation, drywall
- \* All household furniture i.e. treated, painted, stained or upholstered furniture
- \* Plywood – OSB, press board, MDF board (anything that contains a glue product)
- \* Treated Construction Lumber – 2x4's, etc.
- \* Cardboard - Treated

## **Tires**

- \* Must be reported to dump attendant & *tire drop off ticket* is to be completed
- \* Tires must be placed in tire pile

## **Propane Tanks**

- \* Must be *completely* empty, valves removed & put in a separate area beside the metal

## **Electronics**

- \* TV's, computers, printers, tablets etc. to be placed in the electronics bin

## **Burnable**

- \* Clean wood – tree branches, limbs & leaves
- \* NON-TREATED/NON PAINTED construction wood, pallets, wood crates, cardboard

## **Ashes**

- \* Must be cold - *NO HOT COALS*
- \* Must be dumped in the ash pile

## **Metal**

- \* All metals, vehicles & their metal parts.
  - \* Air Conditioners – including portable, central air units, freezers, refrigerators
- ALL MUST BE TAGGED BY A QUALIFIED TECHNICIAN THAT FREON HAS BEEN REMOVED***

## **Wire**

- \* Page wire, barbed wire, cables to be rolled & put in a separate area beside the metal pile

**Creosoted Wood, railway ties, bridge timbers MUST be taken to the Richardson Landfill ONLY (for a fee)**

- **NO oil containers – full or clean – NO used oil filters**
- **NO fuel or oil tanks unless they are clean and dry**
- **NO paint containers – NO paint cans/aerosol cans – full or clean**

**The Town of Fort Frances has a Hazardous Waste Day scheduled for September 12, 2020. Residents are to be taking these items to this event.**

**Failure to sort garbage correctly will result in a total ban of the use of the Landfill sites.**

**Only municipal employees are allowed in the garbage disposal areas**

***Residents are not allowed to go through the garbage.***
